When you register for the meeting, you will be asked to provide an issue for discussion at the meeting, as those issues will be the focus of the agenda. An agenda, including the issues submitted by attendees, will be sent to registrants prior to the meeting.

According to Tom, the hotel that is closest to his office is The Riverside on Las Olas Boulevard, which is 3 blocks away from the meeting location.
