previously informed you,1 the Securities and Exchange Commission held its first annual Municipal Market Roundtable on October 14, 1999. The Roundtable discussed several topics including: issues arising in primary offerings; issues arising throughout the life of a bond issue; electronic disclosure; and fiduciary and other duties of transaction participants.
