In particular, they are developing a standard salary reduction agreement and a standard service provider/"hold harmless" agreement. The goal of the project is to complete a package of materials, including these two documents and a model policy for administering them. The NTSAA and ASBO hope to finalize the materials for release at ASBO's annual conference in October, 1997.
