Securities Industry Association recently submitted to Senate Banking Committee Chairman Phil Gramm a package of proposed amendments to the federal securities laws. Included at pages 11-12 is an amendment to Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act of 1940, to permit an affiliate of a mutual fund to engage in principal transactions with the fund where the fund has adopted policies designed to determine that the price reflects current market value and the transaction reflects such value.
