The application of the definition of "customer" to transactions processed through FundSERV and networked accounts; and 2. The application of the exception for existing customers to exchanges and similar transactions. As instructed on the last conference call with the working group, the Institute has preliminarily raised these issues with staff members of the Securities and Exchange Commission and Treasury and has scheduled a meeting with SEC and Treasury staff on June 12th. The conference call on June 13th will provide an opportunity to report on that meeting.
