In conjunction with the May 3 Board of GovernorsG meeting, the Legislative Affairs Department has scheduled the fourth annual Board of GovernorsG Legislative Briefing in Washington, DC. A copy of the preliminary agenda is attached. In response to your suggestions, we have changed the format for the Legislative Briefing. We will begin before the Board of GovernorsG meeting with a breakfast presentation by Frank Luntz, the Republican pollster who masterminded the Contract with America. (See attached article.)
