at the Pension Committee meeting on October 11, the Institute is establishing a Task Force
to discuss technical and operational issues that would arise if a social security reform
program similar to that proposed by Senators Simpson and Kerrey were to be implemented.

type accounts "Personal Investment Plans" with a portion of their social security tax. The
