Trainees study at their own pace, while the course's computer-based format makes learning enjoyable and easy-to-retain. The enclosed demonstration diskette provides several samples of lessons from the course, as well as information on the benefits of computer-based training. The training course is divided into six modules, each of which is followed by a module test. Upon completion of all six modules, trainees must pass a final exam to "graduate" from the course and receive a certificate of completion.
