Given the various deadlines in the new law, it appears that this rulemaking will be on a very fast track. The Institute is forming a working group of members to consider possible recommendations to the Treasury and/or the SEC in advance of their anti-money laundering rulemaking efforts. We also expect to seek the working group's assistance when we draft comment letters on anti-money laundering rules once they are proposed. The purpose of this memorandum is to solicit interest in participation in the working group and to announce its first meeting, which will be held via conference call at 2:00 p.m. Eastern time on Thursday, November 15th.
