In particular, Nasdaq has filed Amendments Nos. 5, 6, and 7 in response to comments submitted to the SEC on the original proposal. In order to provide the public additional time to comment on the amendments, the SEC has extended the comment period for Amendments Nos. 5, 6, and 7 to September 14, 2000. Comments on the proposed rule change originally were due to the SEC no later than August 30, 2000.
