We are pleased to announce that Barry Barbash, Director of the SEC's Division of Investment Management, will make informal remarks at the luncheon at the New York Forum, and that Juan Marcel Marcelino, District Administrator of the SEC's Boston District Office, will speak at lunch at the Boston Forum. The afternoon session will be an interactive exercise, facilitated by Kathryn McGrath of Morgan, Lewis & Bockius and Meyrick Payne of Management Practice Inc., which will provide directors with an opportunity to share their thoughts with their peers on the differences between the decision making responsibilities of fund directors, the management company, and certain other professionals with respect to various mutual fund issues.
