The Guidelines set out MAS' supervisory expectations for financial institutions' governance, risk management, and disclosure of environmental risk, and align with the TCFD framework. We have already received member questions related to how materiality should be defined under the Guidelines, and how this materiality assessment should be performed for fixed income.
