# Federal Court Strikes Down Missouri Rule Addressing Socially Conscious Investing

The US District Court for the Western District of Missouri <u>struck down</u> several Missouri Securities Division rules that would have required some financial professionals who provide investment advice that "incorporates a social objective or other nonfinancial objective"

(such as environmental, social and governance (ESG) factors) to disclose this fact to their clients and obtain their clients' written consent to state-mandated language. The Court found that the rules are preempted by the National Securities Markets Improvement Act of 1996 (NSMIA) and the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA) and are unconstitutional under the First and Fourteenth Amendments of the United States Constitution.
